Disciples Win Communities

I've heard it said, related to football, and perhaps you have, too: defense wins championships. With baseball, most will say: great pitching wins championships, because great pitching beats great pitching.

In a similar vein, here's a thought I want to throw out to you this month: Disciples win communities.

It has been such a joy to see so many new faces at Beymer – and faces we've seen in the past and now they're coming back around again.

It has been such a joy to feel the energy that comes with a sanctuary full of people ready to worship.

It's been a joy to be able to say to you: we had 295 people in worship on Sunday!

In a faith community, it is often easy to hang our hat on such things, and when we begin to do that, God enters into the conversation to say: now the disciple-making begins.

As a follower of Jesus Christ, I hope it fuels your passion for Christ when you think about what He's done or you and the difference He makes in your life. But I also hope this thought fuels that same passion: one life at a time, we can bring that joy and passion to others – and to an entire community in the process.

Here are two things I want you to consider:

- 1) Are you intentionally growing as a disciple? I know we're talking about that in worship right now, but I want to ask it again here. Are you embracing the core habits: time in Scripture; quiet time with God, seeking the Holy Spirit's presence and direction; time serving others;

developing your prayer life? And I don't mean "want to;" are you? If not, create some change in your life and get started down that path.

- 2) Are you *servicing* in some way at Beymer that helps *us* make disciples?

True disciples make disciples, so are you engaged in helping us do that? We have recently restructured our Church Council and some of our ministry areas in order to clearly focus on one thing: making disciples. So: think about what you enjoy doing most and get involved.

Here's our disciple-making path, with places you can get involved: evangelism (reaching out to the community), welcome (i.e. greeting, follow up with guests), discipleship (i.e. leading a class, hosting a group), helping people find their place to serve, teaching and nurturing biblical financial stewardship, creating mission opportunities to serve the needy. What most sounds like you? Find that, and then get involved.

One person at a time, we can actually draw our entire community into a better place, more full of hope and joy and love. But only if we fully embrace being and making disciples. Because... disciples win communities.

It is such a joy to have you at Beymer!

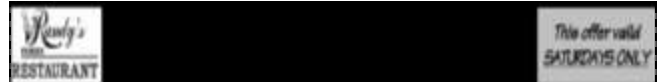

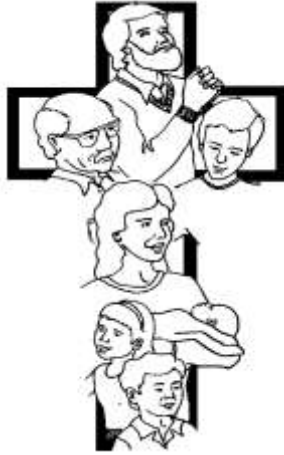
